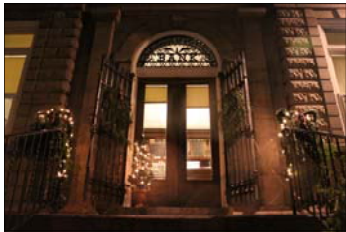

## ZEISLOFF LOG CABIN

The George Zeisloff log house, built in the 1740s, was originally located along Zeisloff Road about a mile west of New Tripoli. It was moved to Ontelaunee Park in 2001. Features include the gunsight/peep hole, “Salen Fenster” (soul window), hand split cedar shakes on the roof, the original lintel, and a 1747 replica 5 plate cast iron stove.



## FORT EVERETT

This fort and its stockade wall is rebuilt with the intent of simulating the approximate appearance of the original fort that was located near the former American frontier along the base of the Blue Mountain or Kittatinny Ridge in colonial times. Benjamin Franklin was charged with having these fortifications built during the 1750s.

## BANK BARN

In 2012, this “Mail Pouch” PA Dutch Bank Barn was moved from its location along Route 309 and revived in Ontelaunee Park. Local artist Jonathan Bond recreated the iconic “Chew Mail Pouch Tobacco” on the side and painted the two barn signs on the front.
